- a. The Great Give Back: The library received multiple donations of clothing. Fifteen people came for the actual give away.

- c. Paychex: They started the first week in October and are providing follow up. Our signature stamp has been returned from the accountant.
- d. Back Door Leak: Multiple people looked at the leak and it is felt that it is a result of leaking gutters from the Historical Society. The Historical Society has told the library staff they are trying to get a lift and contact someone that can get the gutters repaired. Molly states Jim Feely suggested getting an estimate for gutters for the library.

New Business:

- a. Construction Aid Funds: Molly reports a check for \$73,557.00 has been sent to the library for the elevator installation that was completed this past year. Kathy will contact the bank for information on certificate of deposit interest rates so we can earn interest on the money.
- Adopting ALA Suggested Policies; Molly presented recommended policies from the American Library Association. Board members to review policies and will discuss at the next meeting.
- c. Charter: Molly reports they have been working on the charter and have sent questions to the state department. The charter is mostly completed. The plan is to have it submitted by the end of this year.

d. Bond Update: We have been buying a fidelity bond, but this protection is covered in our insurance policy. A cancellation request needs to be signed by a Board member. Kathy Krivitza agreed to sign the cancellation request to cancel the duplicate coverage.
