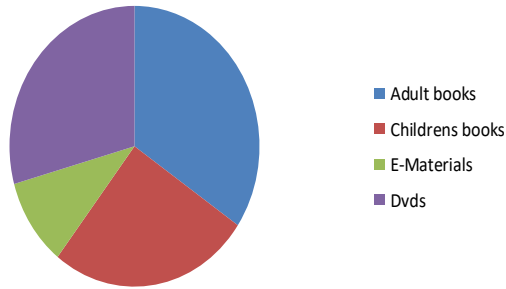

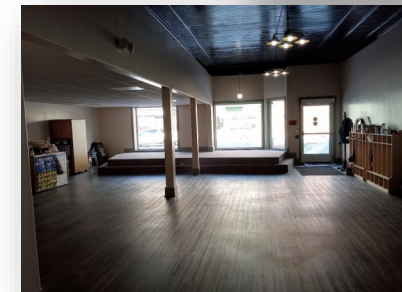

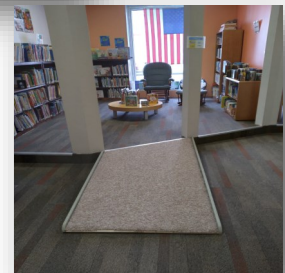
Handicap accessible door!
