New Business:

- a. STLS Presentation by Erica Jenns: Erica is the STLS Assistant Director. She discussed Trustee Roles and Responsibilities and Strategic Planning. A slide presentation was provided.
- b. C of D Expiration: Both C of D's need action taken this month. The C of D from the Operating Account will be deposited back into that account. The Capital Fund C of D will be transferred into a 7-month C of D at 3.6% interest. Jim made a motion to approve these actions, seconded by Sandy; all in favor.
- c. Art Gallery and Partnership: Tom Tripp would like to have an art show to display photos his dad, Ellswood Tripp, took during his tour in the Korean War. It was offered to be done at the Historical Society, but they do not have room for the display. Molly will ask them if they would like to help with this event. Molly will purchase starter kits to display art gallery pieces. Tom would like to have a reception on October 1 and will give a welcome introduction. Jim made a motion to have this art gallery in the library and purchase the

needed supplies, seconded by Claire; all in favor. Jim suggested opening the library from 10-noon on Fall Foliage Saturday. It was suggested to make this viewing time by appointment only. The display is titled "Marilyn by Tripp."
